

Sea Scout Line Officers

The Skipper is the adult responsible for working directly with the Sea Scouts to help them create the program for the ship. The ultimate responsibility for the ship rests with the Skipper. All information from the Ship Committee goes through the Skipper. He or she participates in all ship meetings and activities, and attends all quarterdeck and ship committee meetings, and conductive the annual quarterdeck training. The Skipper sets the tone for the ship, models leadership and helps petty officers become leaders of their own ship.

The Executive Officer is recommended by the skipper, approved by the Ship Committee and appointed by the committee chairman. They are second in command and back up the skipper. The primary role of the Executive Officer is to work in partnership with the youth Boatswain's Mate- Administration. Together they coordinate the recruitment of new members, sustain the interest of the current members, and provide recognition for the individual achievements of crew members

The Operations Officer is recommended by the skipper, approved by the Ship Committee and appointed by the committee chairman. They are third in command and back up the skipper. The primary role of the Operations Officer is to work in partnership with the youth Boatswain's Mate- Program. They discover and survey the interests of the members on an ongoing basis, plan and schedule the activities for the crew, and evaluate completed activities. He or she works closely with each Activity Chair to ensure the youth member experiences success leading the activity

The Medical Officer is recommended by the skipper, approved by the Ship Committee and appointed by the committee chairman. They are required to have medical background.

The Deck Officer is recommended by the skipper, approved by the Ship Committee and appointed by the committee chairman. They are in charge of the Deck Crew.

The Engine Officer is recommended by the skipper, approved by the Ship Committee and appointed by the committee chairman. They are in charge of the Engine Crew.

The Navigation Officer is recommended by the skipper, approved by the Ship Committee and appointed by the committee chairman. They are in charge of the Navigation Crew.

The Security Officer is recommended by the skipper, approved by the Ship Committee and appointed by the committee chairman. They are in charge of the Security Crew.
